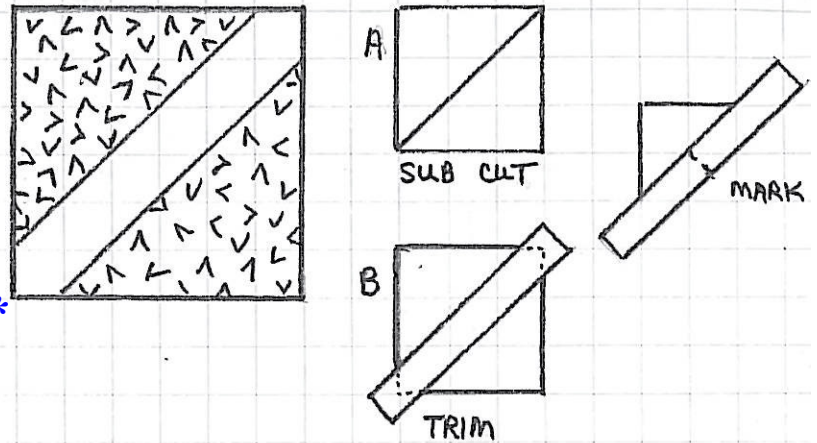


# Block of the Month

EASY AS PIE 6" (6 ½" unfinished)

There's an old expression that's used when a task is simple to do. Have you heard the saying, "easy as pie?" My husband insists that pie is round and cake is square. This is an easy block to make so it's "easy as cake." It's so easy, why not make more than one block for the drawing?

Fabrics : one 30"s reprint, any color print  
Strip is a cream, ecru or muslin tone on tone

Cut: 30's reprint  
1 - 6 1/8" X 6 1/8" Yes, I know this is an odd cut. Now sub cut it as shown in diagram A.  
Strip  
1- 1 ½" x 10" This is longer than needed but the corners will be trimmed after block has been sewn together as in diagram B.

To get the strip centered, mark center of strip and the hypotenuse (isn't that a fun word?) of the triangle. Match these when sewing.
