

O Happy Day Supply List – Online Workshop



Learn how to make this very happy quilt while also having a great time! While playing with color, you will learn five or more techniques on how to make perfect circles, using both hand and machine sewing.

Below is the supply list. Don't go out and buy anything that you don't already have in your studio! I'll help you find a substitute during the class if you are missing one of the supplies. Come prepared to play, experiment, and have fun.

- Assorted fabrics, 10+ pieces that are at least 5" square. Be sure to include a variety of colors and values.
- Freezer paper – approximately 6"x18"
- Double sided fusible such as Heat and Bond or Steam a Seam – approx. 10"x10"
- Single sided fusible interfacing – approx. 10"x10"
- Neutral colored threads that generally match your fabrics
- Basic sewing supplies, including a sewing machine that can zig-zag
- Paper scissors
- Hand sewing needles. If you use a thimble, bring it as well.
- Small, pointed fabric scissors
- Something circular to trace around (circle template, drinking glass – anything!) Should be approximately 2.5-3.5" in diameter

We will be learning both hand and machine applique techniques. If you plan to applique by machine, you may want to use a monofilament thread for the top and a cotton thread for your bobbin. I like Superior Thread's Mono-Poly.
